

#### Scholarships:

Credit Union Association of the Dakotas will award ten \$500 scholarships for applicants that exemplify the credit union philosophy of "people helping people" through volunteering, community service, and leadership. Five scholarships will be awarded to North Dakota high school graduates and five to South Dakota high school graduates. Scholarships will be awarded upon the successful completion of the first semester of college.

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. Applicant must be a United States citizen.
- 2. Applicant must have been a credit union member for at least one year.
- 3. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
- 4. Applicant must be planning to attend a two or four year postsecondary accredited university or a technical/vocational school.
- 5. Credit union must be affiliated with the Credit Union Association of the Dakotas.

#### **Application Requirements:**

- 1. A completed copy of the Dakota Credit Unions' High School Financial Scholarship application form including:
  - · List of volunteer work/job experience
  - List of extracurricular activities/organizations
  - List of accomplishments, honors, and awards received
- 2. A written letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, community leader, or supervisor.
- 3. An essay, not to exceed 500 words, on one of the following questions: "How, through your involvement in the community/school activities, events, or volunteer efforts, have you shown the cooperative spirit?" OR
  - "What can your credit union do to continue providing you with financial solutions for a lifetime?"

#### Judging Criteria:

The judging committee, consisting of credit union professionals from each state, will score each applicant on the following criteria:

- 1. Volunteer work/job experience
- 2. Extracurricular activities/organizations
- 3. Accomplishments, honors, and awards
- 4. Essay

#### Application Deadline:

Applications must be postmarked by March 7, 2016. Applications should be sent to the following address:
