2016 College Scholarship Application

Eligibility

- ❖ The winners will be chosen based on GPA, ACT score, school involvement, and community involvement with precedence to any individual pursuing an agricultural education.
- ❖ Applicant must be a High School Senior and have a current grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- Only current customers of Horizon Resources and their dependants may apply for these scholarships.
- ❖ Immediate Families of board members or employees are not eligible to apply. (Immediate Family members referred to are: parents, siblings, spouse, grandchildren, or the spouse's same immediate family members.)

How to Apply

- 1. Complete the application form in full.
- 2. Include your official high school transcript.
- 3. A current photograph to be used if awarded a scholarship.
- 4. Include 3 letters of recommendations with your application in sealed envelopes. One from local school administration or counselor and two from any school faculty or community patron. Please include names and addresses of each.

- 6. Applications must be post marked April 6th, 2016.
- 7. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

AWARD PROCEDURE

- ❖ 5 \$1,000 scholarship awards will be made to the successful applicants upon completion of their first semester, and after the successful applicants provide Horizon Resources with a transcript of grades and verification of their studies at the accredited college, university or trade school. Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student (enrolled in at least 12 hours of studies).
- ❖ A 2.5 GPA or better is required of the scholarship winners during the first semester prior to the awarding of the scholarship. If the applicant fails to maintain this requirement, the scholarship will be forfeited and re-awarded to the "alternate" selected at the time of judging.
- The check will be made out jointly to the college and the student to be used the second semester of that college year. The check is to be picked up at the Horizon Resources -Williston Main Office.
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, sex or disability.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable.

Selection will be made by a committee appointed by Horizon Resources.
